10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 11 of Title 2.2 an article
12	numbered 8, consisting of sections numbered 2.2-1182 and 2.2-1183, as follows:

14	High Performance Buildings Act.
15	§ 2.2-1182. Short title; definitions.
16	A. This article shall be known and may be cited as the High Performance Buildings Act.
17	B. As used in this article, unless the context requires a different meaning:
18	"High performance building certification program" means a public building design, construction, and
19	renovation program that meets the requirements of VEES.
20	"VEES" means the Virginia Energy Conservation and Environmental Standards developed by the
21	Department considering the U.S. Green Building Council (LEED) green building rating standard, the
22	Green Building Initiative "Green Globes" building standard, and other appropriate requirements as
23	determined by the Department.
24	§ 2.2-1183. Building standards; exemption.
