| 10 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 30-111.1 as follows: |
| 11 | § 30-111.1. Special reports on travel and trip expenses. |
| 12 | In addition to the disclosure requirements of § 30-111, each member shall file with the Clerk of his |
| 13 | house a special report on each gift of travel or trip expenses with a value greater than \$500. The report |
| 14 | shall be filed with the Clerk at least 14 days prior to departure or, if there are fewer than 14 days |
| 15 | between accepting the invitation to travel and the departure date, within 24 hours of accepting the |
| 16 | invitation to travel. |
| 17 | The report shall contain the following: (i) the time, duration, destination, and purpose of the travel |
| 18 | or trip; (ii) the estimated value of the gift; and (iii) the identity of the donor of the gift. |

19 The information on the special reports shall be available for public inspection and shall also be 20 reported pursuant to § 30-111.
