10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 38.2-4910 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 38.2-4910. Right of organization.
13	A. Residents shall have the right of self-organization. No retaliatory conduct shall be permitted
14	against any resident for membership or participation in a residents' organization or for filing any
15	complaint. The provider shall be required to provide to the organization a copy of all submissions to the
16	Commission.
17	B. The board of directors, its designated representative or other such governing body of a continuing
18	care facility shall hold meetings at least quarterly with the residents or representatives elected by the
19	residents of the continuing care facility for the purpose of free discussion of issues relating to the
20	facility. These issues may shall include income, expenditures and financial matters as they apply to the
21	facility and proposed changes in policies, programs, facilities and services. Residents shall be entitled to
