That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 5.1-7.3 as follows: 10 § 5.1-7.3. Duty of care and liability for damages of owners of private landing areas. 11 A. For the purposes of this section: 12 "Fee" means any payment or payments of money to a landowner for use of the premises or in order to engage in any activity described in subsections B and C, but does not include any action taken by 13 another to improve the land or access to the land for the purposes set forth in subsections B and C or 14 15 to remedy damage caused by such uses. 16 "Land" or "premises" means any privately owned area for landing any aircraft, that is not open to 17 the general public, and that is registered with the Department and the Federal Aviation Administration 18 pursuant to § 5.1-7.2. "Landowner" means the legal title holder, lessee, occupant, or any other person in control of the 19 20 land or premises. 21 B. A landowner shall not be liable for ordinary negligence related to conditions on his premises that 22 proximately cause damage to property or injury to occupants of an aircraft or ultralight vehicle landing 23 on or taking off from such premises, provided that no commercial operation is being conducted on or 24 about the premises. 25 C. Any landowner who gives permission, express or implied, to another person to operate aircraft or 26 ultralight vehicles of any type for the personal use of such person or for the use of an easement as set 27 forth in subsection B does not thereby: 28 1. Impliedly or expressly represent that the premises are safe for such purposes; 29 2. Grant invite status or its corresponding duty of care to the person to whom such permission has 30 been granted: or 3. Assume responsibility for or incur liability for any intentional or negligent acts of such person or 31 32 any other person, except as provided in subsection D. 33 D. Nothing contained in this section shall limit the liability of a landowner that may otherwise arise 34 or exist by reason of his gross negligence or willful or malicious failure to guard or warn against a 35 dangerous condition, use, structure, or activity. The provisions of this section shall not limit the liability 36 of a landowner that may otherwise arise or exist when the landowner receives a fee for use of the 37 premises or to engage in any activity described in subsection B or C. Nothing contained in this section 38 shall relieve any landowner who sponsors or conducts any event or competition of the duty to exercise 39 ordinary care in such events.

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
