| 9 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 10 | 1. That § 18.2-490 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of |
| 11 | Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-488.1 as follows: |
| 12 | § 18.2-488.1. Flag at half mast for certain public safety personnel killed in the line of duty. |
| 13 | A. As used in this section, unless the context requires a different meaning: |
| 14 | "Emergency medical services provider" means the same as that term is defined in § 32.1-111.1, and |
| 15 | any member of a volunteer lifesaving crew or rescue squad. |
| 16 | "Firefighter" means the same as that term is defined in § 9.1-300, and any member of a volunteer |
| 17 | fire department. |
| 18 | "Police officer" means any full-time or part-time employee of a police department or sheriff's office |
| 19 | which is a part of or administered by the Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof and who is |
| 20 | responsible for the prevention and detection of crime and the enforcement of the penal, traffic, or |
| 21 | highway laws of the Commonwealth. |
| 22 | "Service member" means a member of the United States armed forces. |
| 23 | B. Whenever a service member, police officer, firefighter, or emergency medical services provider |
| 24 | who is a resident of Virginia is killed in the line of duty, all flags, national, state, and local, flown at |
| 25 | any building owned by the Commonwealth shall be flown at half staff or mast for one day to honor and |
| 26 | acknowledge respect for those who made the supreme sacrifice. |
| 27 | C. The Department of General Services shall jointly develop procedures to effectuate the purposes of |
| 28 | this section. |
| 29 20 | § 18.2-490. Penalty. |
| 30 31 | Any violation of this article shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor. |
| 31 | The provisions of this section shall not apply to § 18.2-488.1. |
