2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia, relating to issuance of special license*
3 *plates for veterans of Operation Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-743. Special license plates for members of the Virginia Defense Force and certain veterans;
9 fees.

10 A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
11 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
12 applicant special license plates.

13 B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
14 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
15 United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
16 design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unmarried surviving spouses of
17 persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
18 plates under this subsection.

19 C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
20 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
21 United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
22 incorporates an emblem of the United States Army.

23 D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
24 the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license
25 plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of
26 state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

27 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
28 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.

29 F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
30 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.

31 G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the
32 Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that
33 campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in
34 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are
35 issued.

36 H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation Iraqi
37 Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

38 I. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
39 Enduring Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation
40 Enduring Freedom.

41 J. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Virginia
42 Defense Force, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Virginia Defense
43 Force.

44 K. *On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation*
45 *Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans*
46 *of those military operations.*

47 L. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued
48 under subsection A, D, E, F, H, I, ~~or~~ J, or K of this section.
