9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 29.1-520 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 29.1-520. Times for hunting.
12	A. Nonmigratory game birds and game animals may be hunted from one-half hour before sunrise to
13	one-half hour after sunset. Bears may be hunted without capturing or taking from one-half hour before
14	sunrise until four and one-half hours after sunset [ by day or by night from 4:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. ]
15	during bear hound training season.
16	B. Fur-bearing animals and nuisance species of birds and animals may be hunted by day or by night,
17	except that muskrats may be hunted by day only.

18 C. A violation of this section shall be punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor.
