Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. § 1. That the Board of Education shall adopt regulations adjusting the formula for calculating the 9 final high school accreditation status as follows: for schools having met minimal accreditation requirements, a minimum numerical value of three points shall be added to the completion index total 10 11 points calculation for each student obtaining (i) a diploma and (ii) an industry certification, industry 12 pathway certification, a state licensure, or an occupational competency credential in a career and 13 technical education program, when such certification, licensure, or credential is approved by the Board 14 of Education as student-selected verified credit. The additional points shall not be used to obtain or 15 deny accreditation.
