7 Special Olympics World Summer Games, captured gold medals in the 10,000-meter race and the half-marathon at the international competition; and

WHEREAS, a remarkable athlete, Karen Dickerson participated in the Marine Corps Marathon and
finished in the top 10 percent of female runners in the 2007 Boston Marathon, completing the race with
an impressive time of 3 hours, 24 minutes; and

17 WHEREAS, Karen Dickerson has participated in Special Olympics for several years, traveling to18 Ireland and China for World Summer Games and meeting fellow athletes from around the world; and

WHEREAS, at the 2011 Special Olympics World Summer Games, Karen Dickerson easily outpaced
her competitors to bring home gold in the 10,000-meter race and the half-marathon, demonstrating once
again to the world her strong spirit and incredible endurance; and

WHEREAS, a talented track and field athlete and inspiring role model, Karen Dickerson proudly
 represented Springfield, the Commonwealth, and the nation at the 2011 Special Olympics World
 Summer Games; now, therefore, be it
