**4. Title:** Approval of electrical utility facilities.

**5. Summary:** Approval of electrical utility facilities. Requires the State Corporation Commission, when considering requests for approval to construct electrical utility facilities, to consider the public health impacts of the electrical utility facility that have been identified in the applicant's most recent integrated resource plan. The measure also requires an electric utility's integrated resource plan to take into consideration public health impacts.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill would introduce a very complex consideration of contested factors in matters before the State Corporation Commission and would likely require either additional staffing with specialized expertise or the use of outside consulting. Such specialized expertise could be expensive.
