4. Title: Physical education; regulations.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to promulgate regulations governing physical education requirements in public schools. The Board shall promulgate the regulations to be effective beginning with the 2015-2016 school year.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any costs related to the development of regulations by the Board of Education concerning physical education requirements in public schools would be nominal and absorbed within current resources. However, once promulgated, these regulations would affect school divisions by prescribing specific requirements for physical education. Any potential fiscal impact resulting from the enacted regulations would not be known until such regulations are approved by the Board of Education.
