4. Title: Physical education; regulations.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to promulgate regulations governing physical education requirements in public schools in consultation with the American Heart Association, American Cancer Society, American Academy of Pediatrics (Virginia Chapter), Virginia Association of School Superintendents, Virginia School Boards Association, and other interested stakeholders. The Board shall promulgate the regulations prior to January 1, 2014 to be effective beginning with the 2015-2016 school year (fiscal year 2016).

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation directs the Board of Education to promulgate regulations governing physical education requirements in public schools in consultation with the American Heart Association, American Cancer Society, American Academy of Pediatrics (Virginia Chapter), Virginia Association of School Superintendents, Virginia School Boards Association, and other interested stakeholders. There is no state fiscal impact anticipated from this legislation. Once promulgated, these regulations will affect public schools; however, any potential fiscal impact resulting from the enacted regulations would not be known until such regulations are approved by the Board of Education.
