**4. Title:** Wake surfing.

**5. Summary:** This bill allows persons to engage in the recreational activity of wake surfing. The bill provides that the speed of a motorboat may exceed the slowest possible speed required to maintain steerage and headway when within 50 feet or less of a person, if such person is (i) being towed by the motorboat or (ii) is accompanying the motorboat, provided that such motorboat is propelled by an inboard motor.
