4. Title: Wake surfing.

5. Summary: This bill allows persons to engage in the recreational activity of wake surfing. The bill defines wake surfing as a competitive or recreational water sport in which a person on a wakeboard, surfboard, or similar style board initially uses a tow rope to reach the top of a wave that is generated by a motorboat and once on the wave releases the tow rope and rides the steep face below the wave's peak using such board, provided that the motorboat is not propelled by an outboard motor, inboard/outboard motor, or water jet.
