5. Summary: Requires counties, cities, and towns to pay the costs incurred by the State Board of Elections in administering local elections held on a date other than the November general election date. The bill takes effect January 1, 2014.

8. Fiscal Implications: State Board of Elections (SBE) states that this bill has minimal fiscal impact on the on SBE. May elections cost the agency a total of approximately \$10,000 to \$15,000. Localities holding the elections will be billed for these expenses.
