4. Title: Board for Contractors; waiver of license requirement for Habitat for Humanity.

5. Summary: This bill adds the rehabilitation of single-family dwellings by Habitat for Humanity, or any other nonprofit organization exempt from taxation under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as a condition under which the Board for Contractors may waive the requirement for licensure. Currently, the authority of the Board to waive licensure is limited to the construction of single-family dwellings.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.
