4. Title: Renewable portfolio standard program; reporting.

5. Summary: Renewable portfolio standard program; reporting. Requires each utility participating in the renewable portfolio standard program to identify, in its annual report to the State Corporation Commission, the states where purchased or owned renewable energy was generated (specifying the number of megawatt hours or renewable energy certificates originating from each state), the decades in which the purchased or owned renewable energy generating units were placed in service, and the fuel types used to generate the purchased or owned renewable energy. (The number of megawatt hours or renewable energy certificates originating from the units and originating from each fuel type shall be specified.) The Commission is required to post the reports submitted by each investor-owned incumbent electric utility on its website.
