5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education, with assistance from the Department of Social Services, to provide awareness and training materials for local school divisions on human trafficking, including strategies for the prevention of trafficking of children.

Fiscal Implications: This legislation could result in some additional administrative costs for the Department of Education and the Department of Social Services related to the development of training materials for local school divisions; however, it is anticipated that any such costs would be nominal and absorbed within current resources.
