3. Committee: Passed both Houses

4. Title: Human trafficking hotline; posted notices.

5. Summary: Provides that any person who owns a business that provides entertainment commonly called stripteasing or topless entertaining or entertainment that has employees who are not clad both above and below the waist and who fails to post a specific notice in a clearly visible place on the premises is subject to a civil penalty of \$500, payable to the Literary Fund. The notice provides the telephone number of the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final; See item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications: Although insufficient data exists to determine the amount, the legislation could result in an increase of revenue to the Literary Fund since violations would be a civil penalty of \$500 and payable to the Literary Fund.

Any fiscal impact that may result from this legislation on the Department of Labor and Industry is anticipated to be minimal and can be absorbed within the agency's current resources.
