3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Redistricting local districts; local government may exclude prison populations from its calculation

5. Summary: Provides that the local governing body may exclude from its calculations in drawing local districts for decennial redistricting the population of certain adult correctional facilities. The bill includes federal and regional, as well as state, adult correctional facilities and allows the exclusion of the facility population if it exceeds 12 percent of the ideal population of an election district for the locality.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill has no fiscal impact on State Board of Elections (SBE) because this population does not affect the number of individuals eligible to register to vote, or cast a ballot.
