Summary:** This enrolled version of the bill provides an exception on the placement of stationary blinds, allowing placement on the shores of Back Bay in the City of Virginia Beach provided that (i) the blinds are limited to the riparian owner's shoreline at mean low water mark or (ii) the blinds were erected and licensed in 2011 by the riparian owners.
