Summary: Provides that all fines and forfeitures associated with criminal violations of local ordinances are paid to the locality, and when a person is summoned or arrested by a law enforcement officer of the State for a criminal offense under the Code of Virginia, he shall be charged and tried for that offense and shall not be charged and tried for a violation of a local ordinance representing a like offense.
