- **8. Fiscal implications:** The appraised market value of the facility is \$30,000. The Accomac property tax assessment is \$142,900, including \$50,000 for land. The proceeds from sale of the property, after deduction of expenses of the sale, will be distributed pursuant to \$2.2-1156. The \$1 transfer results in the loss of at least \$29,999 to the Commonwealth.

In addition, a conveyance at \$1 would not cover the Commonwealth's expenses to process and document the sale.
