4. Title: Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority; changes in composition.

5. Summary: This bill changes the composition of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. The bill includes an emergency clause.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact. Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill will increase the number of members appointed by Virginia from five to seven within this interstate compact. Additionally, the number of representatives from the District of Columbia and Maryland will increase by one each, for a total Authority membership of 17. Member reimbursements for meeting expenses are supported by Authority resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Aviation, Virginia Department of Transportation, Department of Rail and Public Transportation, citizens of Arlington, Alexandria, Fairfax, Loudon, Prince William and Stafford counties.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: This bill is a companion to SB237.
