8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) distributes over 25,000 family planning guides annually. These guides are printed in both English and Spanish. New <u>Virginia Guide to Family Planning, Genetics, and Social Services</u> booklets would need to be produced to incorporate the requirements of this bill. The cost to print both English and Spanish versions would cost approximately \$19,000 annually. The annual distribution expenses for both versions are \$1,800. The initial start-up costs to print and distribute the guide would be \$20,800.
