2. Patron: Ingram

3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Arresting officer to ascertain citizenship of arrestee.

5. Summary: Supplements the existing law that requires sheriffs to make a query into legal presence when a person is "taken into custody" at a jail. This bill expands such inquiries by requiring inquiries of everyone arrested, and requires that an arresting officer inquire of every arrestee whether he (i) was born in a country other than the United States and (ii) is a citizen of a country other than the United States.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary; See item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police does not expect a fiscal impact due to the proposed legislation. The Compensation Board has not reported a fiscal impact on sheriffs with law enforcement responsibilities.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Local and state law enforcement agencies, Compensation Board.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.
