4. Title: Virginia War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission

5. Summary: HB 349 extends the time that the commission may be funded upon the approval of the Joint Rules Committee, and provides that if the commission is not funded by a separate appropriation in the appropriation act for the 2014-2016 biennium, the commission will sunset on July 1 of the fiscal year that it does not receive funding. This bill is a recommendation of the Virginia War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission (VBAWC).

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final; see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The VBAWC was established and funded by the 2008 General Assembly and continues to be funded through FY 2014 in the Governor's recommended budget as well as HB 1301. If the commission is not funded in FY 2013, the bill provides funding by the budgets for the offices of the House and Senate Clerks. The bill also states that if the VBAWC is not funded during the FY 2014-2016 biennium, it will expire on July 1 of the first year of no funding.
