4. Title: Standards of Learning; Board of Education required to report of disciplinary offense & outcome data.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Education to publish annually on its website the disciplinary offense and outcome data by race, ethnicity, gender, and disability for each public school in the Commonwealth. This data must be published in a way that protects the identities of individual students.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no state fiscal impact anticipated as a result of this legislation since the data that would be required for reporting is already collected by the Department of Education. However, due to Federal regulations, some of the data could have to be masked since certain demographics in certain localities are so small in number that individual students could be readily identified in a publicly reported document. The Department of Education would not release any data that would violate any Federal regulations.
