**2. Patron:** Iaquinto

**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Court records; secure remote access; interfacing computer systems.

**5. Summary:** Provides that the operational expenses associated with providing secure remote access to land records includes locating technology in an offsite facility for purposes of improving public access or for the implementation of a disaster recovery plan. The bill extends the prohibition on selling or posting data accessed by secure remote access to include land records. The bill requires the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court to establish security and data standards for interfacing case management system modules and financial management system modules on or before June 30, 2013, and such standards shall be consistent with the policies, standards, and guidelines established pursuant to § 2.2-2009.
