4. Title: Four-for-Life; substantive review

5. Summary: Requires that a reallocation of moneys set aside from the Four-for-Life fees be made pursuant to legislation that has been reviewed by the House Health, Welfare, and Institutions Committee and the Senate Committee on Education and Health. The bill includes technical amendments.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact

8. Fiscal Implications: None.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Health, Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of State Police, emergency medical services organizations, and volunteer rescue squads

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The Department of State Police receives funding from the special emergency medical services fund and Volunteer Rescue Squad Assistance Fund to support its med-flight operations (\$3.1 million) and for the administration of criminal history record information for local volunteer fire and rescue squad personnel (\$25,000) pursuant to Chapter 890, 2011 Acts of Assembly.

The Governor's introduced budget also includes an amendment to supplant general fund appropriation (\$500,000) for the Poison Control Centers with revenues from the motor vehicle registration fee.
