8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles' cost to add an indicator of veteran status to the license will be a one-time cost of \$101,269. The system changes would be made late in FY 2012 in preparation for FY 2013 implementation. This amount could be provided from the agency's existing resources.

The Department of Motor Vehicles and the Department of Veterans Services have been working together over the past year to develop a stand-alone, separate veteran's special identification card, and are now close to being able to provide this service to veterans.
