5. Summary: Provides that a candidate will not be entitled to have his name printed on the ballot unless he has filed all required campaign finance reports and satisfied all civil and criminal penalties imposed under the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act.

Fiscal Implications: State Board of Elections (SBE) states that this legislation can be enforced with minimal fiscal impact; however, active enforcement by SBE without additional staffing would be difficult. Adding a statement to the oath on the Statement of Candidate Qualification signed by the candidate that they have complied with the provisions of Chapter 9.3 of Title 24.2.
