**4. Title:** Public school enrollment; military children.

**5. Summary:** Clarifies language relating to enrollment of students pursuant to a special power of attorney to correspond to language in the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill clarifies language in section 22.1-3 of the *Code of Virginia* relating to the enrollment of children of military families into public schools. When a child is living with a noncustodial parent or other person standing in *loco parentis* in accordance with the provisions of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children, this legislation would deem that child to be a resident of the respective school division for enrollment purposes.

This technical clarification would align the *Code of Virginia* with the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a fiscal impact.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Board of Education and local school divisions.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** This bill is identical to SB190.
