4. Title: Nonnavigable state waters; regulation exclusively by Commonwealth.

5. Summary: This bill declares any river, creek, stream, or branch that is isolated from any other body of water by not being fed or replenished by any perennial streams as nonnavigable waterways. Defined as such, these isolated bodies of water are subject to regulation exclusively by the Commonwealth and are not subject to regulation by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency under the federal Clean Water Act.
