**4. Title:** Law-enforcement officers; campus police officers.

**5. Summary:** Provides that campus police officers, as appointed by public and private institutions of higher education, are included within the definition of law-enforcement officer.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**7. No Fiscal Impact:** Final (see Item #8)

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Currently, campus police officers are not specifically listed under the definition of law enforcement officers. HB771 amends several statutes, including line-of-duty and workers compensation benefits, to add campus police officers to this definition.

According to the Virginia Retirement System (VRS), campus police officers are presently covered as law enforcement officers under the line of duty act (LODA) and the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System (VaLORS). In addition, the Workers' Compensation Commission does not expect any material fiscal impact from this legislation. Given this, it is not anticipated this legislation would have any additional fiscal impact on state resources. The following chart reflects the number of campus police covered at each institution.
