**4. Title:** Authorizes the Disability Commission to establish work groups and repeals sunset date

**5. Summary:** This bill repeals the sunset date for the commission, which under current law expires on July 1, 2012. In addition, it provides that the Virginia Disability Commission shall establish work groups to assist the Commission in carrying out its powers and duties. Such work groups shall include work groups focused on issues related to (i) housing and transportation, (ii) education and employment, and (iii) publicly funded services, and may include such other work groups as the Commission deems necessary.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No Fiscal Impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill is not expected to have any fiscal impact. The introduced budget includes funding for the commission so the repeal of the sunset does not result in any fiscal impact. In addition, the bill states that the workgroup members shall serve without compensation.
