3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Required meetings of regulatory boards at Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.

5. Summary: This bill replaces specified intervals and number of meetings for certain regulatory boards at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) with the requirement that such boards meet at least once each year.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Any fiscal impact associated with this bill will be immaterial. With fewer board meetings, expenditures will be reduced, as costs associated with board meetings will be avoided. According to DPOR, expected savings are approximately \$2,100 per fiscal year. These savings will be incorporated into cost assessments per the Callahan Act (Section 54.1-113, Code of Virginia); however, the agency anticipates that any impact on these estimates will be minimal.
