- 4. Title: Relax penalty requirements for text messaging and emailing while driving
- **5. Summary:** This bill permits law enforcement officers to issue citations to violators who either text message or email while operating a moving motor vehicle. Under the current legislation, police must have due cause to stop or arrest a driver for some other violation prior to issuing a citation for texting or emailing.
