4. Title: Solid waste landfill; Rockbridge County.

5. Summary: This bill allows the Rockbridge County landfill to operate for an additional two years (until January 1, 2015) or until it reaches maximum capacity, whichever occurs sooner. The landfill is currently scheduled to be closed by the Department of Environmental Quality on December 31, 2012.
