4. Title: Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children; makes numerous revisions to Compact

Summary: The enrolled bill provides that regulations cannot prohibit the placement of a non-resident child in a children's residential facility in the Commonwealth by a custodial parent who assumes full financial responsibility for the child prior to final approval of the placement pursuant to the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children when the placement is made without the involvement of a public officer or agency.
