- 3. Committee: Transportation
- 4. Title: Increase the penalty associated with odometer tampering
- **5. Summary:** This bill adds language to § 46.2-112 of the Code of Virginia, which makes compliance with 49 USC § 32704 of the Federal Odometer Act in the service, repair, or replacement of an odometer also compliance with subdivision D.2. of this section. In addition, the minimum civil penalty resulting from violation of section A or B of § 46.2-112 would be doubled from the current \$1,500 to \$3,000.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate (see Section 8)
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how much in additional revenue could result from this proposed legislation, due to potentially larger damage amounts. However, any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
