5. Summary: Requires persons who appear at their polling place or at the central absentee voter precinct on Election Day and who have returned an unused or spoiled absentee ballot to cast a provisional ballot, rather than an official ballot, at the polling place or precinct.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Final Fiscal Impact Estimates: None, see line 8

8. Fiscal Implications: State Board of Election (SBE) states that this legislation has no fiscal impact on the agency. However, the bill could have a minimal fiscal impact on localities due to the possible increased use of provisional ballots.
