3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Elections, administrative matters, and duties of the electoral board and general registrar.

5. Summary: Provides for certain administrative efficiencies. It permits general registrar to administer oath to voting equipment custodians; clarifies method to give notice of change in location of general registrar's office; modernizes procedures to give public notice of registration times and primaries; and permits absentee ballot envelopes to be opened before election day so long as the ballots are placed in a secure ballot container and no count is initiated.

8. Fiscal Implications: State Board of Elections (SBE) states that this legislation will have no fiscal impact on the agency. SBE also indicates that this legislation should generate some cost savings for localities.
