Summary: This bill requires solid waste planning units and localities with a population of greater than 90,000 to annually prepare and submit a recycling survey report to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). The bill further requires solid waste planning units or localities with a population of 90,000 or less to prepare and submit a recycling survey report to DEQ every four years.
