**59** whole number, the presiding officers of each house shall appoint a committee of three, which together  
**60** shall constitute the joint committee to count the vote of each house in each case and report the results to  
**61** their respective houses. The joint order may be suspended by the presiding officer of either house at  
**62** any time but for no longer than twenty-four hours to receive the report of the joint committee.
