10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 2.2-3300 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-3300. Legal holidays.
13 14	It is the policy of the Commonwealth to fix and set aside certain days in the calendar year as legal holidays for the people of Virginia. In each year, the following days are designated as legal holidays:
14	January 1 - New Year's Day.
16	The Friday preceding the third Monday in January - Lee-Jackson Day to honor Robert Edward Lee
17	(1807-1870) and Thomas Jonathan (Stonewall) Jackson (1824-1863), defenders of causes.
18	The third Monday in January - Martin Luther King, Jr., Day to honor Martin Luther King, Jr.,
19 20	(1929-1968), defender of causes.
20 21	The third Monday in February - George Washington Day to honor George Washington (1732-1799), the first President of the United States.
22	The last Monday in May - Memorial Day to honor all persons who made the supreme sacrifice in
$\overline{\overline{23}}$	giving their lives in defense of Virginia and the United States in the following wars and engagements
24	and otherwise: Indian Uprising (1622), French and Indian Wars (1754-1763), Revolutionary War
25	(1775-1783), War of 1812 (1812-1815), Mexican War (1846-1848), War Between the States
26	(1861-1865), Spanish-American War (1898), World War I (1917-1918), World War II (1941-1945), Karran War (1950-1952), Vietnere War (1965-1972), Operation Deset, Shield Deset, Stern
27 28	Korean War (1950-1953), Vietnam War (1965-1973), Operation Desert Shield-Desert Storm (1990-1991), Global War on Terrorism (2000-), Operation Enduring Freedom (2001-), and Operation
20 29	Iraqi Freedom (2003-). On this day all flags, national, state, and local, shall be flown at half staff or
30	mast to honor and acknowledge respect for those who made the supreme sacrifice.
31	July 4 - Independence Day to honor the signing of the Declaration of Independence.
32	The first Monday in September - Labor Day to honor all people who work in Virginia.
33	The second Monday in October - Columbus Day and Yorktown Victory Day to honor Christopher
34 35	Columbus (1451-1506), a discoverer of the Americas, and the final victory at Yorktown on October 19, 1781, in the Revolutionary War.
33 36	The Tuesday after the first Monday in November - Election Day for the right and privilege of
37	citizens of a free society to exercise the franchise.
38	November 11 - Veterans Day to honor all persons who served in the Armed Forces of Virginia and
39	the United States in the following wars and engagements and otherwise: Indian Uprising (1622), French
40	and Indian Wars (1754-1763), Revolutionary War (1775-1783), War of 1812 (1812-1815), Mexican War (1846-1849) Was Difference (1861-1865) Second Lange (1864-1865) Was difference (1864-1865) and the second se

48 49	December 25 - Christmas Day. Whenever any of such days falls on Saturday, the Friday next preceding such day, or whenever any
49 50	of such days falls on Sunday, the Monday next following such day, and any day so appointed by the
51	Governor of the Commonwealth or the President of the United States, shall be a legal holiday as to the
52	transaction of all business.
