2 An Act to amend and reenact § 4.1-215 of the Code of Virginia, relating to alcoholic beverage control; 3 tied house; exemption.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 4.1-215 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 4.1-215. Limitation on manufacturers, bottlers and wholesalers; exemptions.

9 A. Unless exempted pursuant to subsection B, no retail license for the sale of alcoholic beverages 10 shall be granted to any (i) manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler of alcoholic beverages, whether licensed in the Commonwealth or not; (ii) officer or director of any such manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler; (iii) 11 partnership or corporation, where any partner or stockholder is an officer or director of any such 12 manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler; (iv) corporation which is a subsidiary of a corporation which owns 13 or has interest in another subsidiary corporation which is a manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler of 14 15 alcoholic beverages; or (v) manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler of alcoholic beverages who has a financial interest in a corporation which has a retail license as a result of a holding company, which 16 17 owns or has an interest in such manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler of alcoholic beverages. Nor shall 18 such licenses be granted in any instances where such manufacturer, bottler or wholesaler and such 19 retailer are under common control, by stock ownership or otherwise.

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a manufacturer of malt beverages or wine, whether 21 licensed in the Commonwealth or not, may obtain a banquet license for a special event as provided in § 4.1-209 upon application to the Board provided that such event is (i) (a) at a place approved by the 22 23 Board and (ii) (b) conducted for the purposes of featuring and educating the consuming public about 24 malt beverage or wine products. Such manufacturer shall be limited to no more than four banquet 25 licenses for such special events per year. Where the event occurs on no more than three consecutive 26 days, a manufacturer need only obtain one such license for the event.

- B. This section shall not apply to:
- 1. Corporations operating dining cars, buffet cars, club cars or boats;
- 29 2. Brewery or winery licensees engaging in conduct authorized by subdivision A 5 of § 4.1-201;
- 30 3. Farm winery licensees engaging in conduct authorized by subdivision 5 of § 4.1-207;

31 4. Manufacturers, bottlers or wholesalers of alcoholic beverages who do not (i) sell or otherwise furnish, directly or indirectly, alcoholic beverages or other merchandise to persons holding a retail 32 33 license or banquet license as described in subsection A and (ii) require, by agreement or otherwise, such 34 person to exclude from sale at his establishment alcoholic beverages of other manufacturers, bottlers or 35 wholesalers; or

36 5. Wineries, farm wineries, or breweries engaging in conduct authorized by § 4.1-209.1 or 4.1-212.1; 37 or

38 6. One out-of-state winery, not under common control or ownership with any other winery, that is 39 under common ownership or control with one restaurant licensed to sell wine at retail in Virginia, so 40 long as any wine produced by that winery is purchased from a Virginia wholesale wine licensee by the 41 restaurant before it is offered for sale to consumers.

42 C. The General Assembly finds that it is necessary and proper to require a separation between 43 manufacturing interests, wholesale interests and retail interests in the production and distribution of 44 alcoholic beverages in order to prevent suppliers from dominating local markets through vertical 45 integration and to prevent excessive sales of alcoholic beverages caused by overly aggressive marketing techniques. The exceptions established by this section to the general prohibition against tied interests 46 47 shall be limited to their express terms so as not to undermine the general prohibition and shall therefore **48** be construed accordingly.
