14	state law, prohibiting discrimination in housing, employment, public accommodations, credit, and
15	education on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions,
16	national origin, age, marital status, or disability.
17	B. The locality may enact an ordinance establishing a local commission on human rights which that
18	shall have the powers and duties granted by the Virginia Human Rights Act (§ 2.2-3900 et seq.).
