

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to vest title to real property of the former Town of Waterford to the County of Loudoun.*

5 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

6 **1. § 1.** *That title to all real property held in the name of the former Town of Waterford, whose charter*  
7 *was repealed by Chapter 280 of the Acts of Assembly of 1936, shall be vested in the County of Loudoun*  
8 *without any further act or deed. The Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County shall have and may*  
9 *exercise the powers to alter or vacate the streets, alleys, and other public rights-of-way as laid out in*  
10 *accordance with the survey and plan of the former town made pursuant to Chapter 161 of the Acts of*  
11 *Assembly of 1874-75, and to authorize encroachments thereon, using the procedures set forth in*  
12 *§§ 15.2-2006 through 15.2-2010 of the Code of Virginia.*
