11	United States; and
12	WHEREAS, the benefits of companion animal ownership are enjoyed by an estimated 100 million
13	Americans, including four million Virginians; and
14	WHEREAS, companion animals provide not only loyalty and love to their owners, but in many
15	cases, therapeutic and emotional support as well; and
16	WHEREAS, companion animals are all too often the victims of cruelty and abuse; and
17	WHEREAS, the Humane Society of the United States and its affiliate in Virginia have worked
18	tirelessly and effectively for the protection of companion animals for many years; and
19	WHEREAS, the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) has been a
20	tireless voice for animal welfare; and
21	WHEREAS, it has been shown that animal abuse is often an indicator of dysfunctional human
22	relations and domestic violence as well; and
23	WHEREAS, companion animal advocates assemble in Richmond each year during the General
24	Assembly session to give voice to their support for legislation enhancing the protection of companion
25	animals; now, therefore, be it
26	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
27	January 23, in 2013 and in each succeeding year, as Companion Animal Protection Day in Virginia;
